


WORKING TOGETHER FOR A STRONG RAITH ROVERS

Since the suspension of football earlier this year, we have been working with the football club and other fan groups to help secure the future of the club we all love. We have engaged positively with the RRFC Board and offered our assistance where we can. We were proud that the Trust's donation to the club took the fund-raising effort by the supporters over the £100k mark. This tremendous effort shows the importance that fans play in our football club. They are the heartbeat of Raith Rovers. The Supporters Trust also worked with the club to help cover the cost of any season ticket refunds as a result of the League One season finishing early, ensuring that the club didn't lose out financially.

The continuing lack of fans at games is a frustration, both for the club and for the support, but we obviously need to be mindful of the difficult situation that COVID-19 brings. Over the coming months we will be working with the club to help get fans back to Stark's Park safely as soon as possible. Football is nothing without fans and the sooner we are back in the stands cheering on the team the better.

ASKING THE TOUGH QUESTIONS

The Raith Supporters Trust exists to make sure that Raith Rovers Football Club has a strong, sustainable future. We work positively with the Board of the football club and other fan groups to help the club year-on-year, but we are also focused on making sure that the club has a healthy future in the long-term. That is why we have been the main funders of the highly successful Roary Club initiative, which seeks to build the future generation of Rover's fans. It is also why at the recent Q&A session with owner John Sim we asked some challenging questions on ownership, finances, and season ticket pricing for children.

Raith Rovers has made massive progress in creating a better atmosphere for kids, but at £65 for new supporters we are the third most expensive club in Scotland for this age group, with only Celtic and Rangers being more expensive. After extensive research, we did put proposals for a more realistic pricing strategy for children to the club, but regrettably they did not take us up on this. We still believe there is a better way and we will continue to make the case for a fairer approach for younger fans.
